"I have finally reached my goal of 1000 sleeping mats which were distributed first to African countries but since Covid, to the homeless in Kitchener, Stratford, Brantford & Cambridge. I started this venture after Christmas of 2013 when my oldest brother introduced this type of mission project to me. The early years I took used bags from wherever I could find them and made approximately 60-65 mats per year, which went with a mission group to Zambia, but with Covid putting a halt to travel to these countries I found an outlet by donating them to the homeless right on our doorstep, Kitchener & Cambridge."
